Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

The children are settling well into their new classes and it is lovely to see our new Reception children enjoying their time in school. Thank you to the parents who came along to our workshops this month. We hope you found it useful. The Maths workshops will take place in November.

Timekeeping

Thank you for bringing your children to school on time. I have noticed the children are coming in to school before the morning bell is rung ready to line up in their classes. We recommend the children arrive in the playground first thing so they can meet their friends for a short play before coming inside to start their school day.

Phonics and Maths Workshops

We have received some feedback regarding the change of the timings for our workshops. We had low attendance at many of our workshops last year and overwhelmingly parents wanted workshops to still feature rather than any other ideas we offered. Therefore we are trialling different timings to see if this has more of an impact on our parents. We are hosting shorter, more concise workshops after drop off so parents can then get on with the rest of their busy days.

Change of Inset Days-20th and 21st July

I would like to notify you of a change to two of the inset days that were originally set by the local schools this year. The 20th July 2020 and 21st July 2020 are now inset days and will replace the 22nd May 2020 and 3rd July 2020. Bucks CC had originally planned for a county wide training event which has now been postponed. Therefore the local schools got together and agreed it was better to move these dates to the end of July.

School Hot Lunches

We are aware that many children are choosing jacket potatoes for their hot lunch. The teaching staff go through the menu for the next day with the children prior to them making their choices. We understand it is important for the children to enjoy a varied lunch and therefore we will now only be offering jacket potatoes as a choice on a Tuesday and Thursday. The children will still be able to choose the meat or vegetarian option for that day and the arrangements will remain the same for children with allergies.

We would also like to encourage you to discuss the menu with your child at home which will help them with their choice too. The menu for the term is available to view on our website.

Parent's Coming in to School

Please help us to keep your children safe. Due to safeguarding procedures parents should not be in school unless they have signed in.
