Safety in the Sun

Before half term we sent out our sun safety leaflet but as a reminder we would like to offer the following advice. <u>Please ensure your child has a sun hat in school</u>. You may wish to apply sun cream to your child before coming to school or in the playground. Guidelines recommend that children are exposed to sunlight in the early morning or late afternoon (for 20-30 mins) a day so that the UV light can activate vitamin D to prevent rickets (an increasing problem in Britain). Applying sun cream in the playground can help this process. You can supply sun cream for your child to apply themselves at lunchtime. Please ensure it is named.
