Wellington Boots

We have a collection of wellington boots in the gazebo at the front of the school. Please can you check to see if any of these belong to your child. Any remaining boots will be recycled after Friday 15th November. Please can you also check that your child has a pair of wellington boots in school that are the correct size for them. Thank you.

Attendance

There has been a flurry of requests for children to be taken out of school during term time.

As a statutory requirement we monitor every child's attendance. We would like to let you know that if a child's attendance has fallen below 90% we are required to write to you. 95% attendance or below is a cause for concern.

We would like to remind you that it is important that children come to school regularly and on time. Children are not permitted time off school to go on trips, shopping or holidays. If parents do request time off for such events they will be unauthorised by the school.

We are committed to offering children the best start to their school life. Promoting regular attendance is part of this commitment. We are confident you will support our efforts.

Periods of unauthorised absence can result in the County Attendance Team issuing a penalty notice. This is in line with Section 444 of the Education Act, Local Authority Guidelines and agreed School Policy. Please note that information in regards to term time holidays is available within the schools attendance policy and has been agreed by governors.

A penalty notice may be issued at a fine of £60 per parent/carer, per child if paid within 21 days. This would rise to £120 per parent/carer, per child, if paid between 21 in 28 days and could lead to further court proceedings if unpaid.
