Developing coordination, creativity and control through structured PE activities

Learning songs and singing them together

## Maths

Exploring patterns in numbers - eg odd and even, doubles and multiples  
Develop our confidence in developing strategies to support us when adding and subtracting (eg using number bonds)  
Consolidate our understanding of numbers to 10 and explore number patterns beyond



## Communication, Language and Literacy

Talk and write about what we did during the Easter Holidays  
Develop our skill and fluency when reading and writing captions and sentences using Phonic strategies  
Writing postcards  
Sequence familiar stories - eg Handa's Surprise



## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Circle time discussions and Show and tell.  
Develop our ability to work collaboratively on projects and activities - eg building large scale houses in the outdoor environment  
Playing games with rules  
Exploring the ideas of resilience and perseverance  
Discuss why we take turns, need to wait our turn and look after our classroom
