Schoolgateway Online Payments

We have the Schoolgateway in our school which is an online payment system. Schoolgateway enables you to make online payments to school for trips and clubs. You can make payments using the Schoolgateway app on your smartphone or from the Schoolgateway website.

We take bookings and payment for WASPS (the before and after school club) and for other school activities.

To start using Schoolgateway please follow the instructions below for registering.

Download the app: If you have a smartphone, please download School Gateway from your app store (Android and iPhone). The app shows the same information as the website PLUS you can send app messages to the school for FREE - this will also save the school money when we send text messages.

OR

Visit the website: <u>www.schoolgateway.com</u> and click on 'New User'. You'll receive a text message with a PIN number. Use this PIN to login to School Gateway.

We'll notify you by text or email when new items are available for payment.

If you're having trouble logging in, it may be because the school doesn't have your current email and mobile phone number on record. Please call the school and we'll update the details on our system.

We hope that you will find School Gateway to be a fast and easy way to pay for school items.

Water Bottles
