Homework

Reading:

- Reading at least 3 times weekly at home (5-10 minutes - read anything!). Regular reading at home has a significant impact!
- Reading books will be changed on Monday (4 books). We will change books if written in the diary.
- There are benefits in reading a book more than once to build confidence and fluency.
- New phonemes will be sent home when introduced (ie in phase 5)



Spellings:

- No set weekly spelling tests but at the end of every half term we will check the Year 1 common exception words and high frequency words. Please practice reading and writing throughout the year.

My Maths:

- All children will be given a log in for My Maths. Homework will be set once every two weeks.

Purple Mash

- All children have been given a log in to a website called Purple Mash. There are many activities and skills they can practice on there. Specific activities may be set in the 'To do' section.



Phonics

- We are using Supersonic Phonic Friends to deliver daily phonics
- Introducing precursive script for writing (children will adopt when ready)
- Currently recapping Phase 3 digraphs and Phase 4 blending and segmenting skills before introducing Phase 5 sounds.
- Phonics screening test - pure decoding skills. All children in Year 1 will take the check. It usually takes place in June.


- Phonics play - some free activities including real and nonsense word games

Phonics – Supersonic Phonic Friends


Taught through :




Phonics – Phase 5

- Alternate graphemes introduced - ay, ou, ie, ea, oy, ir, ue, aw, wh, ph, ew, oe, au
- Split digraphs.
- Alternative pronunciations of graphemes
- Alternative spelling of phonemes
- Reading and spelling more new 'tricky' words
