

Starting School

When you come to school you need to bring with you:



- \Rightarrow your book bag
- \Rightarrow your PE bag
- \Rightarrow your coat
- \Rightarrow your water bottle
- \Rightarrow wellington boots

You leave your PE bag on your peg at school, but take the other things home with you every day. You will need a t-shirt, shorts and plimsolls for indoor PE. Are all your clothes marked with your name? It helps when you lose something.



In the Summer term you will join the whole school in participating in the daily mile.

All children at our school wear school uniform. in burgundy and grey. Book bags, PE bags, sweatshirts, cardigans, winter hats and sunhats are sold at the uniform shop in Aylesbury. We think it is very important to wear a sun hat.







Helpful Hints

Pegs

When you come to school you will have your own special coat peg in the cloakroom to hang your coat and PE bag on.



Milk and Munch



We have a piece of free fruit every day. If you would like to have a drink of milk with your fruit, please ask a grown up at home to fill in the form. We give you your own water bottle which you can fill with water

and bring to school every day.

<u>Bells</u>

The school bell will ring at 8.50am in the morning for the start of school. When you hear the bell you can enter school with your classmates. Reception children enter school through the side door into the classroom.



At first, your mummy or daddy can help you come into school. After a few weeks, we hope you will be able to come in by yourself.



<u>Wet play</u>



When it is raining, playtime takes place in the classroom. Special 'wet play' toys are kept in each class.

Every day

Every day as you come in, put your book bag in your tray, hang up your coat, and sit down on the carpet ready for registration.





Special Times

Sharing assemblies are special times every Friday when we share all the good things that have happened during the week. We have 'Special Choosing' time on Friday afternoons when you can choose what to play with your friends.









Other special things include school trips, plays, visiting Theatre groups, Harvest Festival, Open evenings, Christmas party, Sports day, Concerts and Curriculum Focus weeks.



We have lots of visitors in our school who show us how to do things like dance, sing and juggle. They talk to us about interesting things too.
