#### New Library and Y2 Outdoor Classroom

During the Summer holiday we have made some significant changes to the inside of our school. Building work took place to relocate our library to a lovely new space which was the central classroom. This area will now be a new library and breakout area for working groups. The school corridor has been opened up with the removal of two small walls and work benches have been installed to make a new ICT area containing new Chromebooks. There is more space in the corridor for small working groups too. The library will be finished in October when the furniture will be fitted.

The new Y2 outdoor classroom is near completion. Benches were installed this week and blinds to make the area weather proof will be fitted this term. Y2 were already making good use of this wonderful additional space last term.

### School Gate

Please can we ask that you ensure the school gate is always closed behind you. It must not be propped open at drop off and pick up times to ensure of the safety of all of our children. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.

## Dogs at Drop-Off and Pick Up

If your family dog accompanies you to drop-off and pick up you are welcome to tie them to our school fence. Please ensure they are tied up along the pathway and away from the school gate entrance. Some children are not confident around dogs and it can be upsetting for them to walk passed a dog sitting by the gate entrance. Thank you.

## **School Equipment**

Our outdoor classrooms and equipment must only be used by children during school hours when they are supervised by a member of staff. Please ensure that children and their siblings do not play on the equipment or go into the woodland area at drop off and pick up. This is for safety reasons as our insurance does not cover this. Thank you.
